

Book Reviews

Not sure what to add in a book review? Here are some suggestions on what to write.

Make sure to add:

- Title (is any meaning in the title?)
- Author
- If it is an audio book you can add the person narrating the story
- A very brief description of the content of the book (perhaps including the genre)

What you might add:

- What did you like about the book and why? For example:
 - Characters
 - Did you like the writing style?
 - If historical or nonfiction, did you find the material to be factual?
 - Did the story keep you interested in reading, guessing, laughing, crying ...
 - Did the story feel real, whimsical, gritty ...
- What did you dislike about the book? For example:
 - Did you understand or care for the main character?
 - Was it a genre you like / dislike
 - Could you understand what was happening in the book? Was it too easy and you knew what the story would be right away?
 - Did the story flow nicely or was it choppy?
- Finish your review by summarizing what you wrote.
 - Who would you recommend this to? For example, people that enjoy spy and espionage stories, travel nuts, adventure series, Christian Fiction fans, romance readers, classic lovers, or people that want to laugh and cry.

***Remember, you do not have to add all of the above information to make a good review!**
